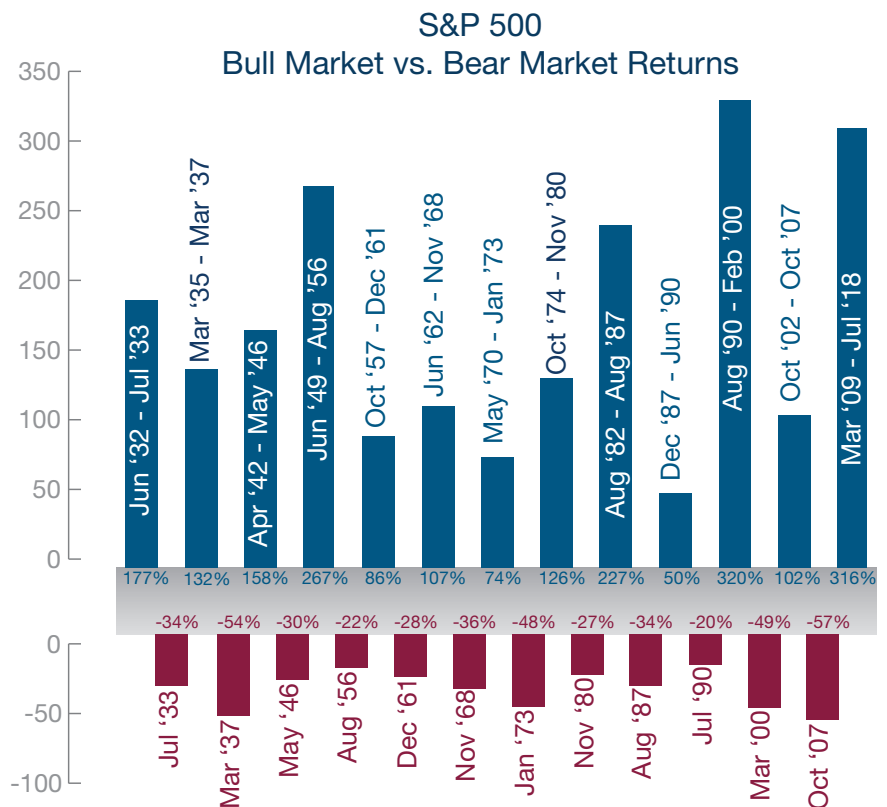


Where Will Your Clients Be When The Bull Market Turns Bear?
